- Responsibility to report accidents, collate accident statistics and investigate any accidents
- Arranges statutory inspections, produce reports and create action plans.
- Environmental & Waste Management responsibilities.

Juan joined the company 01st July 2007 and has significantly improved training, health, safety, environmental and waste management standards within the company, he has successfully overseen 100 projects, of which random HSE inspections were undertaken on 18 of them (22% coverage), with no further action taken from the HSE. Additionally Juan has arranged for over 95% of the workforce to gain NVQ's, CSCS cards and to be DBS checked as required. In 2014 both ISO 14001 and OHSAS 18001 were achieved under Juan's direction. He also manages any BREEAM schemes.
