THE BRIEF

H.H. Smith were awarded a further project at Holy Cross College to undertake the refurbishment works to the Emilie Mary Building. The works included structural refurbishment and recladding of the external face with terracotta rain screen cladding. Works also included the re-skinning of the student services building and installation of new aluminium windows throughout.

KEY POINTS

H.H. Smith have worked alongside Holy Cross College for over 10 years. Working in an occupied environment with young adults requires consideration and constant management to protect the health and safety of the students. This continual relationship demonstrates the service and customer satisfaction that H.H. Smith have given to the College over the years.

CHALLENGES

Working on a very tight site occupied by large numbers of students throughout the working day required exact planning, robust material management and the need to ensure the site was safe and tidy at all times. Access for material deliveries required careful planning and accurate scheduling of deliveries, collections of waste and the need to group staff parking in allocated areas.
