THE BRIEF

Works at the Holy Cross College comprised of major internal alterations and refurbishment of the main student services entrance, along with a new 2 storey infill building to the existing courtyard. These alterations provided the college with not only additional space but extensive upgrades, which in turn improved the college's already impressive facilities.

KEY POINTS

H.H. Smith have worked alongside Holy Cross College for over 10 years. With this project works have totalled £4.75 million. A further extension to the Mary Kelly building has also been awarded to H.H. Smith. This highlights the strong business relationship that H.H. Smith have developed through working with a client to satisfy the construction brief.

CHALLENGES

Working on a very tight site occupied by large numbers of students throughout the working day required exact planning, robust material management and the need to ensure the site was safe and tidy at all times. Being situated on a very busy road with limited means of access needed accurate scheduling of deliveries, collections of waste and the need to group staff parking in allocated areas.
